Transfiguration
Key Scripture: Mark 9:2-9

Read Mark 9:2-9

1. Have you ever had an experience that has left you speechless and in awe? Have you ever felt overwhelmed by the presence of God?

During the sermon, Bishop Kevin Robertson reflected on the transfiguration of the Lord Jesus Christ. He also differentiated between a) the spiritual enrichment that can be experienced when we are 'up on the mountain' and witnessing the Glory of God and b) the work that we are called to do when we are 'sent back' down the mountain and into the world.

- 2. When have you ever felt like you were 'on the mountain?' and in awe of God's Holy presence?
- 3. When do you feel like you have been sent down the mountain to do the work of God?

Bishop Kevin explained that there are six promises that orient us towards God's work that we are called to do, which are rooted in baptismal promises.

Explore the challenges and significance of each of the following promises:

- Will you continue in the apoostle's teaching? In the breaking of bread and in the prayers?
- Will you persevere in resisting evil, and whenever you fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord?
- Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God and Christ?
- Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbour as yourself?
- Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being?
- Will you respect and care for our world, and treat the Earth with sanctity and respect?
